A discussion of significant prosecutions in 2015 and to date in 2016. Advice given by law enforcement to victims of cybercrime. Trends (with a focus on something that they are seeing at Reed Smith, data hostage/blackmail)

Kathie is Co-Chair of Reed Smith's Anti-Money Laundering and Trade Sanctions team and a member of the firm's Global Regulatory Enforcement Group. Kathie joined Reed Smith in 2013 after serving more than a dozen years in the U.S. Attorney's Office in the Eastern District of New York where she was an authority on federal asset forfeiture, money laundering, and complex financial investigations.
